Summer Term

LITERACY

In the first half of the term we will continue our work on the theme of books by Roald Dahl. We will be working on descriptions and sentence building. During the second half of the term, we will be looking at seasons and change. We will discuss holidays, look at map skills and explore the local and wider environment.

Caroline Carney (Speech and language Therapist) will be with us until May, when she will be leaving to begin her maternity leave.

Our IEP literacy activities and letters and sounds will continue daily.

NUMERACY

IEP numeracy will continue on a daily basis through a variety of practical activities. We will be looking at time and developing problem solving skills. We will focus on weights and measures, exploring capacity and volume.

CREATIVITY AND LIFE SKILLS

Through our topic work we will be out in the local community, using our classroom skills in a wider environment. We will be planning routes and making maps, thinking about where each of us lives and learning our addresses. We will be practicing sequencing and retelling stories through drama and music.

HERE I AM

Messengers/Witnesses - the importance of giving and receiving a message, and Pentecost: celebrating the Easter message together.

Treasures - learning about what people treasure and that the world is full of God's treasures.

Change - that people help each other to change and Jesus helped people to change.

P.E

The children will need their outdoor PE kits again this term. We will also be participating in some expressive arts activities including music and movement and dance.

MUSIC

We will be concentrating on singing a variety of songs, linking them to our Literacy, Numeracy and Science topics.

SCIENCE

This term our topic will be growth and change. With this in mind, we will be looking at life cycles of plants and animals.
